Care and Maintenance of "Sea-Sport" Spring Guns

Always keep main compression springs well greased. We suggest Shell Retinax or any light Water Pump grease. Trigger and sear are of salt water resistant metal and these should also have light covering of grease. Do not use oils as these have a tendency to wash off.

4 inch heavy gauge nails can be substituted for loader pin or 6 inch square of heavy canvas duck, with hole for thumb, can also be used quite satisfactorily.

Do not use hardened commercial screwdrivers under 3/16 in. diameter steel as these are likely to snap.

Should front barrel of folding gun develop play, a few cuts with file on flats of pistol handle will take up any looseness.

A small sized reel can be mounted 2 inches in front of ferrule by using two pressure hose geared clips. This will give 40 feet of line for use in deep water and line can easily be taken in without fouling flippers.

It is not necessary to use lead belt when carrying spring gun as approximate weight of 72 in. gun is 6 lb.

Method of Using

Best results will be obtained by holding arm straight at elbow with gun barrel over shoulder. This eliminates any tendency for gun to jump.

Underwater Penetration Range of Sea Sport Guns:

60 in. Single spring, with Duralium spear-8 to 10 ft.

72 in. Double spring, with 7/16 in spear-15 ft. or with reel 20 ft.

84 in. Double spring, with 7/16 in. spear-18 ft. or with reel 25 ft.
